Nov**

- Meet with Advisor to discuss possibility of studying abroad
- Meet with financial aid to discuss financial and scholarship implications
- Gather Info about program options

Dec

- Meet with Dr. Xela Batchelder to discuss BEI N. Ireland Program requirements
- Begin preparing application for WU and BEI

Jan

- Submit BEI and WU application to WU Study Abroad Committee by Jan. 15
- WU Study Abroad Com reviews applications, selects top 3 candidates

Feb

- WU Study Abroad Com submits top 3 applications to BEI by Feb 1 deadline
- Await decision by BEI (BEI usually accepts one applicant, but more have been approved if the program has room)

March

- WU and student notified of acceptance in mid-March
- Meet with Advisor & Registrar to make sure academic requirements for your major and Gen Ed classes are being met

April

- Meet with Study Abroad coordinator about passport, immunizations, travel docs
- Meet with Student Services to plan housing and other details for your return to campus
- Meet with Financial Aid to finalize funding and billing details

Summer

- Finalize any last-minute details about housing, coursework, billing, etc.
- Pack!

Fall

- Have a great trip!
- Stay in touch with Study Abroad coordinator monthly
- Send us pictures and blog posts!

Spring

- Meet with advisor to finalize details about transferring course credits.
